

The ELCA Fund for Leaders scholarship program supports students of tremendous promise attending ELCA seminaries. By making seminary more affordable, the ELCA Fund for Leaders enables more future ministers to go to seminary and helps them graduate with less debt, empowering those whom God calls into ministry to go and serve as the church needs and the Holy Spirit leads.

We are church, and each of us has a unique role to play in furthering the mission and ministry of the church. Your gift to the ELCA Fund for Leaders ensures that highly talented individuals will be able to answer the call to leadership for this church and for our future.

#### Bishop Eaton's Leadership Initiative

In November 2016, Presiding Bishop Elizabeth Eaton announced the <u>Leadership Initiative</u> to inspire ELCA leaders to seek out and encourage gifted people in their congregations, communities and networks to consider a call to the ministry of the gospel, supported by growing levels of scholarships for seminary tuition.

In conjunction with the Leadership Initiative, Bishop Eaton announced a \$3 million gift to the ELCA Fund for Leaders, which provided full-tuition seminary scholarships for 60 additional students over three years. The Fund for Leaders has awarded these 60 additional scholarships in 2017, 2018 and 2019, alongside the scholarships funded by the general endowment of the Fund for Leaders.

The next opportunity to apply for Fund for Leaders full-tuition scholarships will be through an online process from Nov. 15, 2022, to Feb. 25, 2023. To be eligible, applicants must be planning to enroll at an ELCA seminary as first-year students (juniors) in the fall semester of the 2022-2023 academic year, with no more than one semester's worth of coursework already completed. Applicants must also have begun the ELCA candidacy process with the intent of becoming a rostered minister of either word and sacrament or word and service.



In a world full of instability, we don't need opinions or hunches for help; we require the definitive declarations of our mighty and loving God! Join Lucado as he unpacks 12 of the Bible's most significant promises that will equip you to overcome difficult circumstances and stay focused on hope. Laugh Your Way to Grace: Reclaiming the Spiritual Power of Humor by Susan Sparks Laughter--the GPS System for the Soul Laughter was honored by the ancients as a spiritual healing tool and celebrated by the world's great religions. So why aren't we laughing along the spiritual path today? What would happen if we did? In this personal and funny look at humor as a spiritual practice, Rev. Susan Sparks--an ex-lawyer turned comedian and Baptist minister--presents a convincing case that the power of humor radiates far beyond punch lines. 
